Application

Quick Fresh is a mild and gentle cleaner for universal use in the areas of building cleaning (offices, social and sales rooms, etc.) and interior cleaning of vehicles (streetcars, buses, trucks, cars, ...).

The formula delivers very good results, especially heavily soiled floors must be wiped with clear water after cleaning. For special applications and quick results, Quick Fresh is used in high concentrations up to undiluted. Drying before mopping should be avoided to prevent streaking.

Other application concentrations are

Spray extraction: 1:25 to 1:50 diluted with water

Special processes: undiluted to 1:1 diluted with water.
